The fund for the front entrance is added to in two ways. First by any "extra" contributions you make and second, at the end of each fiscal year we take a percentage of the current funds and transfer it to the front entrance fund. The amount transferred is determined by the current WMCA Board based on the number of dues we feel we may receive as well as the amount the association may receive in advertising dollars.
